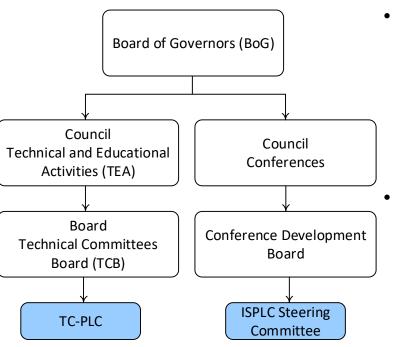

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### 3. Motion for Policies and Procedures (P&P) Update

#### **ComSoc structure (related to TC and conferences)**



- Councils: are responsible for both the policies and oversight of the operations of their Boards/Standing Committees
  - -Technical and Educational Activities (TEA)
  - -Conferences
  - -Member and Global Activities
  - -Publications
  - **Boards**: are the major operational entities of the ComSoc Society and report to Councils
    - TEA→Technical Committee Board (TCB)
    - Conferences → Conference Development Board

### 3. Motion for Policies and Procedures (P&P) Update

#### Current version of TC-PLC P&Ps (2015). Brief document (3 ½ pages) stating:

- Membership requirements
- Officers: number, terms and conditions (e.g., 2 year term, no more than 4 years in the same position) and election procedure (e.g., Nomination and Elections Committee)
- When to celebrate meetings
- Activities (support ComSoc conferences, journal, standardization activities) and budget
- ISPLC

#### **Technical Committees reform started in (TEA) (2018)**

- Too many?
- Need to explicitly define TCs responsibility
- No notion of TC membership
- No consistent path for the creation, merging and termination of TCs

# 3. Motion for Policies and Procedures (P&P) Update

#### New TC-PLC P&Ps (2022). Not so brief document (7 pages):

- Role and objectives (not so new, but now clearly stated in one place)
- Membership requirements:
  - Be ComSoc members (or affiliate members) in good standing
  - Has attended physically present or by teleconference, two or more of the prior five regularly TC meetings
  - Has rendered significant service (objective, measurable and easy to verify conditions added but subject to Director of TB approval)

#### -Officers:

- Terms: 2-year terms. Max 2 terms. Max 6 years in any position (now 8 years)
- Desirable to have at least two candidates per positions. If not, then the N&E Subcommittee can also consider TC non-voting members for adding them to the ballot

# 3. Motion for Policies and Procedures (P&P) Update **New TC-PLC P&Ps (2022).** Not so brief document (7 pages):

- Nominations and Elections Procedure:
  - o Election results shall be authorized by the TCB Director upon consultation with the VP-TEA.
- Awards Subcommittee procedures:
  - Members: Chair (no longer need to be the TC-PLC Chair) + 4 members. All AS members are subject to approval by the TEA Council.
  - Awards need to be approved by the TEA Vice President (VP)
  - The roster of the AS, including members' affiliations, shall be posted on the TC webpage as soon as approved by the TEA Council
  - Nominations will be solicited by email from the TC-PLC members once a year (changed from "inmediately after IEEE ICC" for flexibility)

# 3. Motion for Policies and Procedures (P&P) Update **New TC-PLC P&Ps (2022).** Not so brief document (7 pages):

- ISPLC organization and Steering Committee (SC):
  - All ComSoc conferences must have a Steering Committee (SC). The SC reports to the ComSoc VP of Conferences
  - The role and policies of the SC are defined in the SC Charter. Role:
    - oversees the long-term planning of the conference
    - o plans for future conferences in the series
    - evaluates how well the conference achieved its objectives and proposes and implements improvements
  - o Members:
    - Chair, Vice-Chair, Past Chair and 4 members (now Chair and 4 members)
    - All voting members of the committee shall meet the requirements defined in the IEEE ISPLC SC
       Charter (all voting members of the committee shall be IEEE members holding a grade of Member,
       Senior Member, Life Member, or Fellow, and shall also be members of ComSoc)
